Ellel's Flagship Training Programme

The 9 week event at Ellel Grange is called the Flagship Training Programme of Ellel Ministries for two reasons. Firstly, as the headquarters of Ellel Ministries International. Ellel Grange is the flagship of a fleet of more than 15 Ellel centres round the world. Secondly, the 9 Week Programme was the first long term event held by Ellel Ministries and developed out of the many shorter training courses.

What is the Flagship Programme?

The Flagship Programme is a 9-week, life transforming experience. It will not only change your life but it will also prepare and equip you to be a vessel of God's healing grace in a needy world.

The training and biblical teaching you will receive encompasses the fruit and experience of over 20 years in pioneering healing, deliverance and discipleship ministries. This course offers the opportunity to:

- Receive teaching and gain understanding of key life transforming principles
- Apply these key principles of healing and discipleship into your own life
- Come alongside our experienced ministry team and begin to help others apply these principles in their lives.

Who is the Flagship Programme for?

- Those who have a heart to see a full outworking of Jesus' commission to His Church
- Those with any pastoral responsibilities in the Body of Christ
- Those with a calling on their life to heal the sick and set captives free
- Those with a burden for the abused, the deprived and the broken-hearted
- Those who are in church leadership or lead house-groups, mission or ministry teams
- Missionaries in need of refreshment, encouragement or further training
- Young people preparing for Christian service
- Those at a 'crossroads' of life and uncertain of the next step
- Those moving towards retirement who desire to serve the Lord.

Format

The Flagship Programme includes about 125 teaching sessions divided into different units and some 60 sessions related to the practical outworking of the training. This includes a number of ministry sessions interspersed throughout the training units during the first 6 weeks and gives delegates the opportunity to respond personally to the training. Furthermore there will be small group and open forum discussions. In the 7th week there will be sessions in which delegates receive personal ministry in healing workshops and in the 8th week there is the opportunity to come alongside members of our ministry team to minister on two 3 Day Healing Retreats. The 9th week training brings the whole programme to a dynamic and challenging conclusion.

Delegates invariably testify that the experience gained through the practical sessions reinforces the truth and reality of all that they have heard during the teaching sessions. Delegates leave the course encouraged and excited about putting the principles they have learnt into practice as they seek to be used by God to help and pray for others.

Teaching Content

The teaching content of the programme is designed to give delegates a thorough biblical understanding of the many aspects of healing, deliverance and discipleship. This equips them to help others apply key healing principles into their lives. The teaching is structured around the following main themes:

Foundations and Key Concepts

A clear understanding of basic Christian theology and concepts are essential foundations for effective healing ministry. Topics covered include:

- Foundations of faith (Genesis to Revelation)
- Understanding law, grace and covenant
- Understanding the power and purposes of the cross
- The power and authority of Jesus
- Satan's strategies and tactics
- The healing and deliverance ministry of Jesus

Understanding the Nature and Needs of Mankind

Understanding how God made us and intended us to function as human beings - as well as understanding the consequences of living in ways contrary to God's best. Topics covered include:

- The nature of man – body, soul and spirit
- The ways in which we are damaged in the different parts of our being
- Human relationships and the need for acceptance
- Understanding godly and ungodly soul ties
- Beliefs, mindsets and behaviour patterns
- Sex and sexuality
- Generational iniquity
- Demonic footholds in the life of man
- Carnality and woundedness

- Freedom from fear and anxiety

- Freedom from occult and false religions

Training explains how to be open to the leading of the Holy Spirit, and the skills we need to develop, as we make ourselves available to be used by God to help others. Topics covered include:

- Moving under the anointing of the Holy Spirit.
- Counselling skills
- How to confront in love
- Discernment and deception
- Ministering to the abused
- Intercession, worship and healing

Destiny & Israel

Jesus calls us to preach the gospel, heal the sick, set the captives free and make disciples. Teaching under this theme encourages delegates to step out to enter their destiny using all that they have learnt. Teaching encompasses:

- Cleansing of buildings and property
- Sharing Kingdom truths in your church
- Healing for indigenous people groups
- Israel and the Church in the end times
- Healing and destiny
- The challenge to fruitfulness

The Flagship Programme is also the first stage of the longer 4-stage NETS training programme held at Ellel Pierrepont. For ten years students have been trained on the extensive NETS programme and expanded the horizons of their understanding and experience. There has been amazing fruit in the lives of many people as a result of the NETS Programme. In Stage 2 of NETS, the training is expanded and applied at a deeper level. In Stage 3 students learn more about how to teach and train others, as well as take part in a two to three week mission programme overseas. Finally, those students who are invited to go further with their studies can register for Stage 4. The Flagship Programme is, therefore, the key foundation stone on which the future training programmes are built. While the Flagship Programme will become available at other centres around the world, the NETS advanced training programme will only be available through Ellel Pierrepont.

About Ellel Ministries

The Vision

Ellel Ministries is a Christian Mission Organisation with a vision of welcoming people, teaching them about the Kingdom of God and healing those in need. Luke 9:11.

The Mission

Our mission is to fulfil this vision in accordance with the Great Commission of Jesus and the calling of the Church to proclaim the Kingdom of God by preaching the good news, healing the broken-hearted and setting the captives free. We are, therefore, committed to evangelism, healing, deliverance, discipleship and training. The particular scriptures on which our mission is based are Isaiah 61:1-7, Luke 9:1-2, Luke 9:11, Matthew 28:18-20, Ephesians 4:12 and 2 Timothy 2:2.

Our Basis of Faith

God is a Trinity. God the Father loves all people. God the Son, Jesus Christ, is Saviour, Healer, Lord and King. God the Holy Spirit indwells Christians and imparts the dynamic power by which they are enabled to continue Christ's ministry. The Bible is the divinely inspired authority in matters of faith, doctrine and conduct, and the basis for teaching.

"It was said on this course, 'You can't heal a sin and you can't confess a wound.' Knowing the difference between the two is key. Sometimes there are things only the Holy Spirit can discern and ultimately heal.' On my personal Healing Retreat I received powerful and anointed ministry that released the pain that was very deep and incredibly intense. It was buried and no human could reach it – but the Lord did. I feel released on a profound level. In the creativity course the Lord enabled me to walk in some of my God-given talents with tremendous freedom and to create something that was amazing!"

The History and Name of Ellel Ministries



Ellel Grange

Ellel Ministries derives its name from its first building in England, Ellel Grange, in the parish of Ellel in Lancashire. The name Ellel in old English means "All Hail". In Hebrew it means "God of Gods" or "King of Kings and Lord of Lords". In Chinese it means "Love flowing outwards". So Ellel could be said to mean "All hail Jesus, King of Kings and Lord of Lords" and be expressed as "Love flowing outwards" into a fallen and broken world. The vision for Ellel Ministries was planted in the heart of its founder, Peter Horrobin, many years before the work began here at Ellel Grange in 1986. Ever since, Ellel Ministries has grown rapidly in response to an increasing worldwide need. There are now over 200 full-time workers, and a regular ministry team of over 400 volunteer Associates. Through its many centres round the globe, Ellel Ministries serves the Body of
