The Structure of the School

The course begins with an evening meal at 6pm on the first day and ends with breakfast on the final day, providing you with plenty of time to travel to and from Blairmore House. There will be teaching sessions throughout the week, including group work led by experienced members of the Ellel team and free time to allow you to rest or explore some of the Scottish Highlands.

About Blairmore House

Blairmore House is a homely, lovingly restored Victorian country house. It is located near Huntly in the Grampians of Scotland, and is easily accessible from Inverness and Aberdeen. Previously a private home, a boys' school and a corporate retreat centre, Blairmore House provides the perfect setting for an Ellel training school.

The accommodation is beautifully appointed and very comfortable, and the school buildings provide excellent teaching and recreational facilities. The peaceful setting of Blairmore House is amongst beautiful Scottish scenery, giving views of heather-clad hills, woodlands, and the River Deveron running close by. This, together with the warmth and comfort of the fully heated house - with log fires in the winter - make it an exceptional place for training and restoration all the year round.
