### **Tuition Fees and Costs per Term**

The cost of each term varies according to the level of accommodation selected by the student. It is inclusive of all teaching notes and full board accommodation unless otherwise stated. Fees are payable one month before the first day of term.

### **Mission Supplement**

Students registering for Term 3 will also be responsible for additional expenses associated with the selected overseas mission project. The cost will vary according to the chosen destination and will probably range between £950 - £1150.

### **International Conferences**

From time to time Ellel Ministries hold an International Conference in the UK. Students currently on a NETS school attend these conferences as part of their curriculum. This is a wonderful opportunity to hear a range of outstanding speakers and to be involved in 'hands-on' ministry as a member of the ministry team. There is an additional cost of £200 per student which covers transport by coach, hotel accommodation and all meals.

### **The Ellel Ministries International Diploma**

Students registering for Term 4 of NETS will also be eligible to apply for the Ellel Ministries Diploma. The diploma is recognised and accredited by the Wagner Leadership Institute, Colorado Springs, USA.

### **Special Diets**

We offer a set menu for our main meal and a salad bar for our light meal. We regret we are unable to cater for special diets.

# NETS PROGRAMME

## The Structure of NETS

The NETS training programme is made up of four terms, each of which is 10 weeks in duration. Study on all four terms of NETS can be used in working towards the Ellel Ministries International Diploma which is recognised by the Wagner Institute.

## Certification

All students who complete Term 1 of NETS will receive a certificate equivalent to the 9 Week Flagship School Certificate. Students completing Term 2 will receive a NETS Foundational Certificate; Term 3 students receive the Mission Term Certificate and students completing all four NETS terms will receive the Ellel Ministries Certificate of Completion. Those who demonstrate a practical application of their learning over the four terms, and who fulfill the written and practical assessment requirements, will be eligible for the Ellel Ministries International Diploma in Christian Healing and Discipleship.

## Registration Notes

1. Students will be able to register for all 4 NETS Terms together.
2. Entry to Terms 3 and 4 is subject to students receiving a NETS Department recommendation at the end of Term 2. Acceptance for the Ellel Ministries International Diploma is at the discretion of the NETS Department and Centre Director.
3. The October intake will be able to complete all four terms in sequence between October and the following September. Students in the April intake will be able to complete all four terms in sequence between April and the following March.
4. Those students who cannot manage to take time out to complete two terms in sequence may take Term 1 one year and return the following year to complete Term 2. In this way, NETS may be completed in modules over a four year period.

## Exemptions

1. Students who have completed the full Ellel Ministries 9 Week Flagship School can be accepted into the NETS programme at the Term 2 stage.
2. Students who have completed the Ellel Ministries Modular A and B Training Schools may also be considered for exemption from Term 1.
