## The Structure of the School

On most days two of the three sessions will be devoted to teaching. A varied programme of prayer projects, recreation, personal studies and prayer time will occupy the other sessions - either in the afternoons or evenings. Sunday will be a day of rest, recreation and worship, and will include communion as part of the Sunday morning devotions.

There will be one day set aside in the middle of the School for recreation, with an opportunity to explore some of the beauties of the Scottish countryside.



## About Blairmore House

Blairmore House is an extremely homely, lovingly restored Victorian country house. It is located in the village of Glass, near Huntly in the Grampian region of Scotland, and is easily accessible from Inverness and Aberdeen. Previously a private home, a boys' school and a corporate retreat centre, Blairmore House provides the perfect setting for an Ellel training school. The accommodation is beautifully appointed and very comfortable, and the school buildings provide excellent teaching and recreational facilities. The peaceful setting of Blairmore House is amongst beautiful Scottish scenery, giving views of heather-clad hills, woodlands, and the River Deveron running close by. This, together with the warmth and comfort of the fully heated house - with log fires in the winter - make it an exceptional place for training and restoration all the year round.



# THE TEACHING CONTENT

## The Main Topics to be Covered:

### Prayer and intercession - understanding the difference

Preparing the way for a dynamic relationship with God and learning how to fulfil His purposes through prevailing prayer and informed intercession.

### Preparing to pray and be an intercessor

It is important to understand the link that exists between the effectiveness of our prayer life and our personal walk with the Lord before going any further.

### Learning to live in vision and fulfil the purposes of God

Vision, faith and obedience are the keys to living in the reviving power of the Holy Spirit. Through vision each of us can understand what is on God's heart. Through intercession the obstacles to fulfilling the purposes of God are overcome. Without intercession, visions will remain unfulfilled.

### Intercession and healing

Intercession and healing are inseparable. This very practical unit teaches and illustrates the many different aspects of intercessory prayer that are part of God's healing strategy: *prayer of worship; prayer of praise; prayer of cleansing; prayer of protection; prayer of consecration; prayer of declaration; prayer of covenant; prayer of agreement; prayer of strength, health and guidance; prayer of reaching out for God's will; prayer of tongues; prayer of fasting; prayer of desperation; prayer of battle; prayer of 'having done all else - stand'; prayer of faith; prayer of breakthrough; prayer of quietness; prayer of sealing.*

### Intercession and spiritual warfare

Spiritual warfare is all about using military strategy to win spiritual battles and bring down the strongholds of the enemy. In some Christian circles there is much talk about spiritual warfare, but there are very few Christians who understand the importance of winning spiritual battles in order to take territory on the ground. This is vital teaching for the Body of Christ.

### Planned intercession

Good planning, envisioning the saints, and strategic information all lay the groundwork for powerful intercession. This unit teaches how effective organisation is essential.

### Lessons on prayer and intercession from the Word of God

Throughout the school there will be special devotional units illustrating key principles of intercession from the Bible.
